Description

Road Marking Paint is suitable for traffic marking or painting asphalt or concrete surfaces. It is based on a thermoplastic acrylic resin, which provides elasticity and durability.

Instructions for Use

SURFACE PREPARATION

Apply on clean, dry surfaces. Remove all surface contamination, e.g. dust, pebbles, oil stains or other contaminants. Previously painted surfaces are cleaned and any flaking paint is removed prior to painting. Road Marking Paint is ready for use, it can however be thinned with **Thinner 11/11** (Peletico's product), up to 10% by volume for brush or roller application and up to 20% by volume for airless spray application.

APPLICATION

Thinning/Cleaning: Thinner 11/11 (Peletico's product).

Application tools: Brush, Roller or Airless spray.

Application Temperature: Ideal temperature for the application should be between 5-35°C and the relative humidity should not exceed 80%.

Stir well before and during use. Apply at least two coats.

Cleaning of Tools: Remove as much paint as possible from tools and clean immediately with Thinner 11/11(Peletico's product).

PACKING: 1L, 4L & 20L.

COLOUR RANGE: White, Black, Yellow, Blue, Evergreen (P137), Brick Red (P123) and Pewter (P129). Please refer to **PELELAC®** Peletico's colour chart.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and/or extreme temperatures. Close the container after application.
