Fungicide Solution

Description

Fungicide solution which eliminates, removes and prevents the development of fungi and other micro-organisms on interior and exterior surfaces. It can be applied on new or existing surfaces of brick, concrete, plaster, wood or on already painted surfaces.

Instructions for Use

SURFACE PREPARATION

Surfaces should be free from dirt, dust, oil stains and dampness. On surfaces with mildew, fungus etc remove all loose residues before applying **MX3**. Spray over surface, avoiding over spraying. After 15 minutes wipe over using a cloth or sponge to remove the mould. In case the surface is not completely clean, repeat the procedure. When surface is dry it can be painted over. For more protection against future growth of mould and fungi, apply **Maxicote Fungicide Emulsion** (Peletico's product).

APPLICATION

Thinning/Cleaning: Ready for use.

Application Temperature: Ideal temperature for the application should be between 5-35°C and the relative humidity should not exceed 80%.

Shake well before use. During application wear a protective face mask and gloves.

Cleaning of Tools: In case a cloth or sponge is used during application, wash thoroughly with water and soap before disposal.

PACKING: 500ml.

COLOUR: Colourless.

STORAGE: Store in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and/or extreme temperatures. After use, twist trigger nozzle to "OFF" position.
